The Anton Anderson Tunnel between Bear Valley and Whittier charges the following tolls:

Passenger cars and recreational vehicles under 28'	\$ 12.00 per vehicle round trip
Recreational vehicles over 28'	\$ 20.00 per vehicle round trip

****We recommend that for 12:30PM departures that you take the 10:30AM tunnel opening to connect with our cruise.**

This tunnel is open 15 minutes at the beginning of each half hour for traffic from Bear Valley to Whittier and for 15 minutes at the beginning of each hour from Whittier to Bear Valley.

Cancellation Policy-Individual Cruise Passengers

- Full refund less \$25.00 fee, if reservations canceled 8 days or more in advance. 25% cancellation fee if canceled within 2 to 7 days prior to cruise date. No refund for cancellations made less than 48 hours of cruise date.
- Alaska Railroad Transportation- Full refund if canceled 8 days or more, less \$25.00 fee.

Change Penalties:

- 26 Glacier and/or Motor Coach – a fee of \$25.00 per reservation will be charged for any date changes. Reservations changed less than 48 hours before the cruise remain non-refundable.
- Alaska Railroad Transportation – a fee of \$25.00 per booking will be charged for any changes. No changes allowed 7 days prior to travel and tickets are non-refundable.

CLOTHING: We recommend wearing layered, informal clothing and comfortable non-skid shoes. It's also good to pack a water repellent jacket and sunglasses.

FOOD: Complimentary hot, wild Alaskan cod lunch baskets are served aboard the vessel. Chicken, Vegetarian, and children's hot dog lunch baskets are available with prior notice. Please contact us if you have special dietary needs.

BEVERAGES: Coffee and tea are complimentary self service on each deck. There is a full service bar on board. Cocktails and a variety of non-alcoholic beverages are available for purchase in the galley. Under State Law, it is illegal to bring your own liquor aboard the vessel.

CHILDREN: Busy crew members appreciate conscientious parents that ensure the safety of their children and comfort of other passengers. We recommend that baby strollers be left in your vehicle.

HOMELAND SECURITY: Weapons of any kind are prohibited on board. Coolers, luggage and large hand carry bags are not permitted. Backpacks and carry-ons are subject to search.

Driving to Whittier

From Anchorage take the Seward Highway southbound for approximately 50 miles. Make a left turn at the Portage Glacier sign and drive approximately 7 miles to the Anton Anderson Memorial Tunnel. The fee at the toll booth is \$12.00 per standard vehicle. Larger vehicles may cost more.

You'll arrive in Whittier just after exiting the tunnel. The parking lot is located just past the railroad awning, and over the railroad tracks. There will be a gravel lot on the right hand side, where there will be a parking attendant to collect \$5 CASH from you to park for the entire day.

The diagram below shows the way from the parking area to the PHILLIPS CRUISE SHIP DOCK. Please stay on the sidewalk, walking PAST the cruise ship terminal. Turn right behind the white covered walkway and follow the paved pathway to the boarding gate of the day cruise lot.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION
The International Cruise Ship Terminal is a restricted area. Only international cruise ship passengers are permitted entrance. They do not provide facilities for day cruise passengers.
